Affiliation (E-mail address): Calibri 11 pts, normal, centered

(DOUBLE SPACE, 24 PTS)

Abstract: The abstract should be written in one-column format, using Calibri 10 pts font, italic, alignment justified, with minimal line spacing. The abstract should contain a maximum of 200 words.

(SINGLE SPACE, 12 PTS)

Key words: Calibri 10 pts, normal, lowercase

(DOUBLE SPACE, 24 PTS)

1. TITLE: CALIBRI 10 PTS, BOLD, ALIGN LEFT

(SINGLE SPACE, 10 PTS)

The paper must be written in English, carefully checked for correct grammar and spelling.

The paper size must be set to A4 with **NO page numbering**. The right margin must be set to 1.5 cm and other margins to 2.5 cm.

The recommended font is CALIBRI 10 points in size. Your paper must be written in **TWO** column format, where **column width** is set to **8,25 cm** and the **space between** the columns to **0,5 cm**.

Camera-ready paper should be single-spaced, with a paragraph indentation. Alignment of body text must be justified.

Since the proceedings will be published in the electronic form, there are no limitations to the use of colors in the paper.

There are no limitations to the number of pages.

(SINGLE SPACE - 10 PTS)

1.1. Subtitle (10 point, bold, sentence case, align left)

(SINGLE SPACE – 10 PTS)

The paper should include: (a) title; (b) authors name(s), affiliation and present address; (c) abstract; (d) key words; (e) an introduction, explaining the nature of the problem, previous work, purpose and contribution of paper; (f) body text; (g) a conclusion section which should clearly indicate advantages, limitations and possible applications; (h) a reference section (see References).

Formulas should be written in 10 points size, centered and marked with a number in parentheses on the right, e.g.

(SINGLE SPACE – 10 PTS)

$$1 + 1 = 2 \quad (1)$$

(SINGLE SPACE – 10 PTS)

Tables and figures should be labeled with numbers and described by captions.

The figures should be followed by the word **Fig.** followed by consecutive numbers (e.g. **Fig. 1.** Text, 10 point size).

All table and figure captions must be centered.

The tables should be followed by the word **Table** followed by consecutive numbers (e.g. **Table 1.** Text, 10 point size).

(SINGLE SPACE – 10 PTS)

The figures should be followed by the word **Fig.** followed by consecutive numbers (e.g. **Fig. 1.** Text, 10 point size).

All tables and figures should be centered, if possible.

(DOUBLE SPACE - 20 PTS)

2. TITLE

(SINGLE SPACE – 10 PTS)

Columns on the last page should have equal lengths. (**Hint:** place the cursor at the end of the text on the last page. Then go to **Insert -> Break -> Continuous**. Microsoft Word will create a continuous section break which will equalize column lengths on the last page.)

(DOUBLE SPACE - 20 PTS)

3. CONCLUSION

(SINGLE SPACE - 10 PTS)

The paper should also include a conclusion section. References should be indicated in the text by a number in

square brackets, e.g. [1]. References should be numbered in the order cited in the camera-ready paper. Camera-ready papers should be sent as a **non-protected PDF** document. The maximum file size is 20 MB.
